

Summer positions as classroom aides with our summer literacy and math program Paid opportunities with the district before and after school program





- 60+ P-TEACH graduates are currently enrolled in Colorado university teacher preparation programs

What's Next for P-TEACH

- Goal is to reach 300 participants annually
- Transfer Agreements with other Colorado Universities
- Student Teachers through CU Denver P-TAP (Paraprofessional to Teacher Advancement Pathway)
- Expansion to the Colorado Teacher Degree Apprenticeship
- Support P-TEACH replication in partner districts -Adams 12, Weld RE 3, Estes Park and starting soon Mesa D-51, Durango, Cañon City and Greeley
