#### May 2025

- **Call for Presenters:** A proposal form will be emailed in the next couple of weeks which will invite members to submit presentation requests for the 85<sup>th</sup> Annual Convention.

#### June 2025

- **Annual Conference Registration and Reservations:** The 85th Annual Convention Registration will open on June 2, 2025.
